In the past few weeks, there are many interesting activities to be highlighted with our Buds One Class, Amanda and Ivy



Using recyclable materials and open-ended/loose play is our focus.

We did material collage on the CDs using fabric scraps, paper scraps and glitters, then we hanged these decorated CDs outside on the veranda as sun catchers. They shines under the sun and makes interesting patterns on the floor.
